

'THE LONDON TRILOGY'

AN INDEX



The three novels which comprise the so-called London Trilogy are the first books of the fifteen-novel sequence of Williamson's 'Chronicle of Ancient Sunlight'. They are :

		covering the period	abbreviated here to:
<u>The Dark Lantern</u>	(1951)	June 1893 to July 1895	TDL
<u>Donkey Boy</u>	(1952)	March 1897 to Spring 1907	DB

Most of the action in these three novels takes place in South London in the neighbouring districts of Brockley ('Wakenham'), Ladywell ('Randiswell') and Lewisham (never actually named or given a fictional name). Much of this area is detailed in the Map provided. Robert Tierney, one-time resident in the area, provides us with a good deal of information in his article 'Places and Associations in Young Phillip Maddison' in H.W.Society Journal no.15, March 1987; some useful identities: 'Bereshill' - Forest Hill; 'Beau Brickhill' - Aspley Guise, Bedfordshire; 'Comfort Road' - Comerford Road, Brockley; 'Cross Aulton' - Carshalton, Surrey; 'Cutler's Pond' - South End Pond; 'Fordesmill' - Catford; 'High Road' - High Road, Brockley; 'High Street' - High Street, Lewisham; 'Reynard's Common' - Hayes Common.

To include every reference in the three novels (total 1,248 pages) would be impracticable and, I believe, would serve no useful purpose. There are, for instance, several hundred references to The Hill, Hillside Road, Charlotte Road and London itself which I have left out. Also, there are many real and imaginary people (and places) who receive only brief passing mention in the trilogy and are, in my view, just not worth inclusion in this Index e.g. Dr Crippen, the Quantock Hills. I have had to be ruthlessly selective.

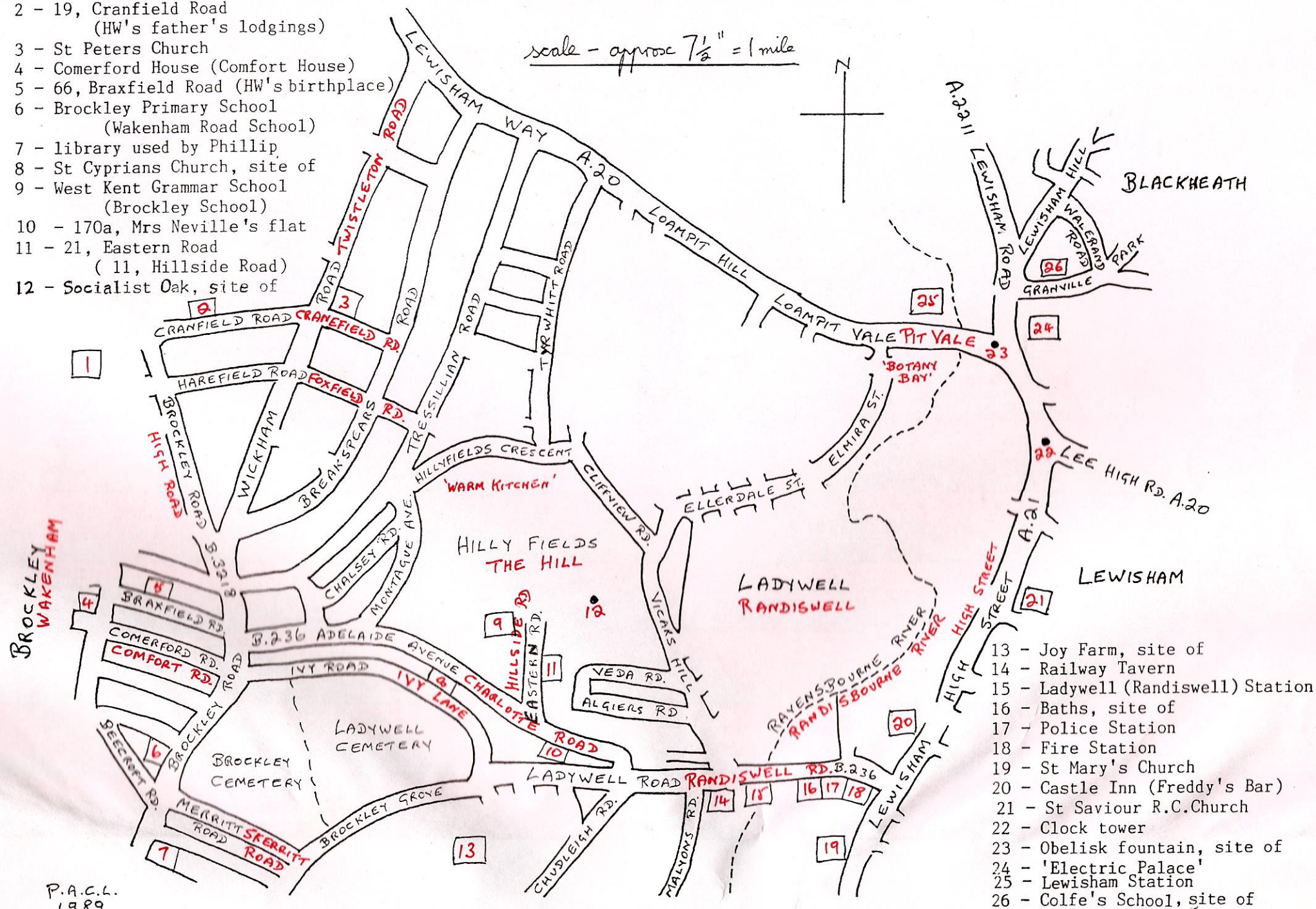
The three most important characters in the trilogy are, I believe, Richard Maddison, his wife Hetty and their eldest child Phillip. I give them 'special treatment'. The references to the characteristics and personalities of these principal characters are, more often than not, the comments, remarks and reflections of the other characters in the novels, and may be wrong, exaggerated or even malicious - the reader must decide for himself.

Only nine dates are given in the trilogy which covers the 20-odd years from 1893 to 1913 (see 'dates' in Index). There are, though, some useful references to specific events which can be easily dated e.g. the Diamond Jubilee (1897) and the sinking of the Titanic (1912) (see 'datable events'). But the reader who forgets that the Chronicle novels are fiction can expect to be somewhat exasperated at times.

This Index cannot claim to be definitive. There are some 7,000 references, all unchecked, and there may well be some errors and omissions.
