## Notes.

Richard Maddison's date of birth is never given, but there are 1. several pointers in the Chronicle, some of which are confusing and contradictory or inconsistent. The earliest clue is in ch.7 (page 92) of The Dark Lantern when in September 1893 Richard tells Hetty that he is in his 28th year. Easy. However, we are later told that his birthday was in September (TDL p 238) - if he had not yet actually celebrated his 27th birthday when he told Hetty he was in his 28th year, surely he should have told her that either he was 'nearly 27' or was 'now 27'. I think that we should take it that he became 27 in September 1893, which would indicate that he had been born in September 1866. But in June 1897 Richard tells us that on his next birthday he would be 32 (DB p 57) this indicates that he would become 32 in September 1897, which in turn indicates that he was born in September 1865. And in April 1908 he admits to being 42 (YPM p 66) which would seem to confirm that he was indeed born in September 1865. (We remember that Richard's character was drawn directly from the author's own father, William Leopold Williamson, who was born in 1865 - see Anne Williamson's biography page 4.)

But then we recall that in December 1894 Richard had told his prospective new employers that he had worked for Doggett & Co for 10 years since just before his 17th birthday (TDL p 276) which tells us that he was now 27 (if I've got my sums right!), which indicates that he was born in September 1867! Then, in March 1897, Richard is said to past his 30th year (DB p 12), which presumably means that he had become 30 in September 1896, pointing to his year of birth being 1866 again.

We know that Richard was a Special Constable during the 'Bloody Sunday' riot in November 1887.(TDL p 110) I have established that to be enrolled as a police officer he would have had to be 21 or over, so Richard must have been born in September 1866 or earlier.

To refer again to our first clue - if Richard had been born in 1865 he would not have told Hetty, in September 1893, that he was in his 28th year, for at any time in 1893 up to September he would have been in his 29th year, and from October 1893 on he would have been in his 30th year.

On the evidence given us in the 'London Trilogy', at least, I have decided, on balance, that Richard was born in September 1866.
