Risk Assessment

This risk assessment is undertaken to comply with our insurance policy.

- Members are reminded that it is their personal responsibility to decide on the level of their capability and whether they should participate in any of the Society's weekend activities.
- The front door of the Hotel Rembrandt has several steps, but there is level access via a side door. All the main communal rooms – reception, restaurant, bar, lounge, function room, swimming pool – are on the ground floor.
- The Hotel has two floors. There are ground floor accessible rooms, and lift access to the first floor. Any Members with mobility issues should discuss this with Reception when booking.
- Any Member choosing to use the swimming pool and other leisure facilities does so at their own risk.
- During the visit to Max Gate, Members should be aware that there are stairs to the upper floor, and no lift access.
- During the visit to Moreton, care should be taken as access to the grave and church are via a public road with no pavement.
- If anyone offers a lift in a private car, they should ensure that they have insurance cover for passengers.
- Any activities engaged upon from breakfast onwards on the Sunday are at Members' own risk and are not covered by the HWS insurance.
