

## Honeymoon 1925: Some Postcards from the Battlefields





To: F. Hibbert, Landcross, N. Devon.
'May 28 1925. Arras. We walked many miles here yesterday, and have now taken about 2 hrs to get ½ mile! We cannot be bothered to go on – we are sitting in a cornfield just outside Arras.'





To: W.L. Williamson, 13 Old Broad St. 'Comparatively untouched, this part! HW. 1.6.25.'



To: Mrs Williamson, 11 Eastern Road. 'Here 1.6.25. Even with all this the Bosches were untouched, mostly, in their concrete m.g. emplacements. HW?
