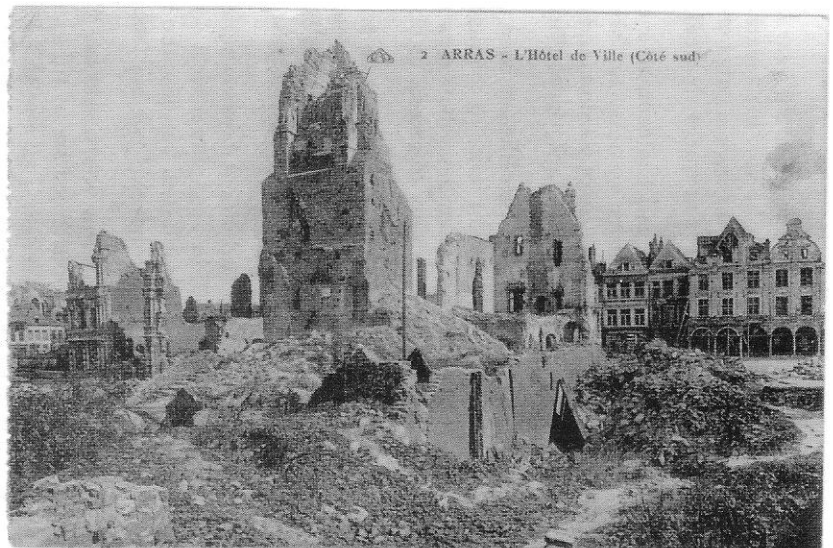


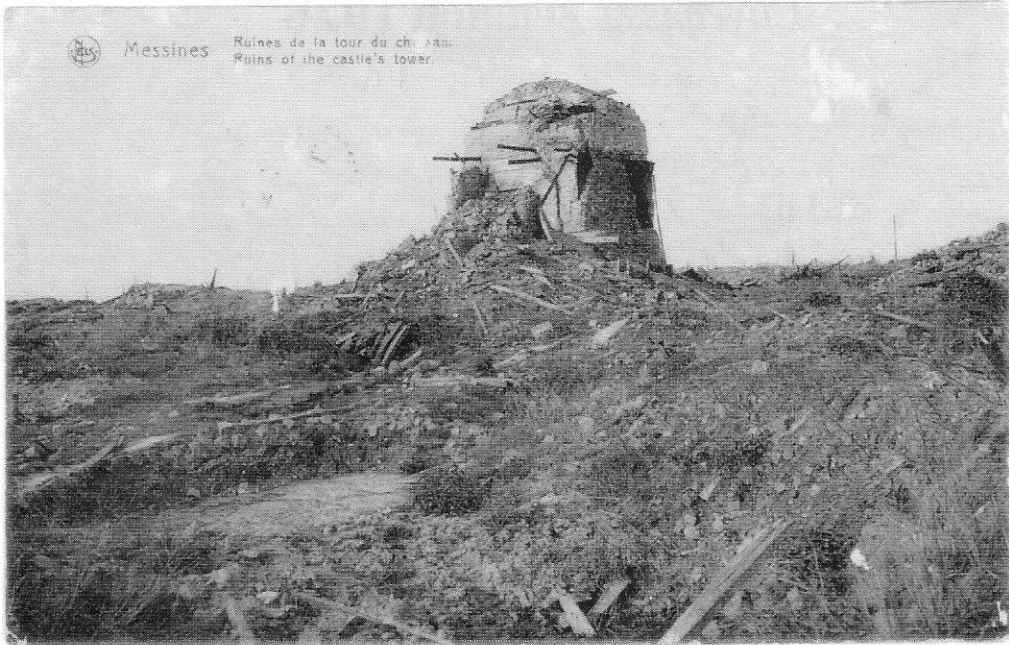
Honeymoon 1925: Some Postcards from the Battlefields

'21.5.25. We arrived here last night and depart
today for Albert, whence we start to walk, . . .
Goodbye, it is lovely weather, but very hot with
heavy packs. Love to all, H.W.W.*

*To: F Hibbert, Landcross, N. Devon.
'May 28 1925. Arras. We walked many miles here
yesterday, and have now taken about 2 hrs to get 1/2
mile! We cannot be bothered to go on - we are sitting
in a cornfield just outside Arras.'*





To: W.L. Williamson, 13 Old Broad St. 'Comparatively untouched, this part! HW. 1.6.25.'



To: Mrs Williamson, 11 Eastern Road.
'Here 1.6.25. Even with all this the Bosches were untouched, mostly, in their concrete m.g. emplacements. HW'
